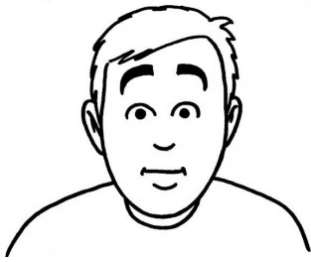


# NZSL Grammar



## Yes/No Questions

Yes/no questions require a simple 'yes' or 'no' reply. Use the following features to signal a yes/no question.



1. Raise eyebrows (widen eyes)
2. Lean chin slightly forward
3. Hold last sign in the sentence (usually with a pronoun sign)
4. Look directly at the listener

### Yes/no question examples:

#### English

1. Are you Deaf?
2. Do you know him?
3. Do you have a pen?

#### NZSL

1. you DEAF you
2. you KNOW he
3. you HAVE PEN you

Practice the following yes/no questions:

1. Is your name Pam?
2. Are you learning NZSL?
3. Do you know NZSL?
4. Is she your NZSL teacher?
5. Do you understand?
